1. Meeting call to order at 1:33PM by Merlyn Carlson
2. Welcome to Committee, MCDOT and Residents.

4. Current Updates:

MCSO: Sgt. Polly White: I did some research on the last golf cart seatbelt installation event in SCW. It was about two years ago and was not well attended. We did the same seatbelt event in SC and it was very well attended. We can look into having another installation event this fall and maybe with more advertising the event will do much better.

Q: Merlyn Carlson: Who does the work and what is the cost?

A: Sgt. White: A grant is possible through the Governor's Office of Highway Safety. We had deputies and volunteers installing the seatbelts and doing safety checks on the golf carts. I will follow up on the startup cost.

MCDOT Updates:

Roger Ball: At my meeting with SHOA, they expressed some changes they would like in the safety brochure. And like PORA they will need to find a way to pay for the printing cost.

John Merkel: I will see if the Posse could stuff the new Safety First brochures in the fall Posse mailing.

Dan Clements:

- The concrete valley gutter installation project is completed.
- The milling overlaying in SCW is in progress.

John Counts:

- Granite Valley Dr., in front of the Del Webb Hospital, study has been completed. We found that in an 8- hour period 135 people crossed that street all over the place.
- We will be putting a traffic signal at the intersection of Granite Valley Dr. and Dachtler Rd.
- At Granite Valley Dr. and Mantor Ln. we will be putting in a pedestrian signal. Both should be completed by June 2013.

Merlyn Carlson: The Rec Center has said they will help with the cost. Contact and get an update on the cost of the sign. There is the issue of the cost and who will run and maintain the sign.
